**Timothy Scott Dorway Charged with Seven Counts of Possession of
Pornographic Work Involving Minors**

Carver County Attorney Mark Metz announces that on December 15, 2016, the Carver County Attorney's Office filed a formal complaint in Carver County charging Timothy Scott Dorway, 44, with seven counts of Possession of Pornographic Work Involving Minors in violation of Minnesota Statute §617.247.

Mr. Dorway was arrested at his home by the Carver County Sheriff's Office on Tuesday, December 13, 2016. Mr. Dorway is the principal at the Chanhassen High School.

On Thursday, December 15, Mr. Dorway made an initial court appearance before Judge Janet Cain in Carver County District Court for the purpose of a bail hearing and otherwise setting conditions of release. Judge Cain set bail at either \$100,000 cash or \$100,000 bond. In addition, Mr. Dorway was ordered to have no unsupervised visitation with his children or other minors. Any supervised contact must be conducted by an adult with knowledge of the complaint and the adult supervisor must be within sight and sound of any visitation. In addition, Mr. Dorway may not use the internet, nor may Mr. Dorway be in possession of any internet capable devices. Mr. Dorway was otherwise ordered to not leave the state, remain law abiding and make all future court appearances.

Mr. Dorway will be arraigned on the alleged charges on Friday, December 23, 2016, at 8:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard.
