Carver County Sheriff Jim Olson reports that sheriff's deputies responded to a threats complaint at Chanhassen High School on 2/28/2018 at about 3:15 p.m. A group of students overheard another student making threats against the Chanhassen High School, which they reported to school officials. The school officials immediately contacted the deputy who works in the school as a school resource officer (SRO).

Sheriff's deputies investigated the matter, including serving a search warrant at the subject's residence. A juvenile male has been detained in connection with this investigation.

Sheriff Jim Olson, in consultation with school officials, increased uniformed deputy presence at the school on 3/1/2018 as a precaution.

This matter remains under investigation by the Carver County Sheriff's Office and Eastern Carver County Schools.
