Carver County Sheriff Jim Olson reports that on July 29, 2018, at about 5:57 p.m., deputies were dispatched to a single motor vehicle crash involving a motorcycle. The call was reported by a witness passerby.

Deputies arrived shortly after being dispatched and found Carver Fire Department personnel performing CPR on the injured passenger who has been identified as Carli Renee Stoutenberg (32) of Belle Plaine. She was in critical condition and was subsequently transported by Ridgeview Ambulance to Hennepin Health Care.

According to the witness, the motorcycle was traveling west on Main Street West in Carver, approaching Jonathon Carver Parkway, when the motorcycle began to wobble, ejecting both the rider and passenger from the motorcycle.

Michael Allan Stoutenberg (37) of Belle Plaine was the rider of the motorcycle. He said he and Carli had just left a local bar before the crash. Michael was transported to 212 Medical Center for injuries sustained in the crash. Deputies obtained a search warrant to collect a blood sample from Michael, which was collected without incident.

The Minnesota State Patrol responded to the scene to conduct crash reconstruction investigation.

The blood sample evidence will be examined by Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension Crime Lab. This matter remains under investigation by the Carver County Sheriff's Office.
