ABOUT THE CARVER COUNTY RESERVE UNIT

Carver County is located in the southwest metro area and is one of the fastest growing counties in the state. Carver County has 358 square miles, 19 lakes and rivers, 11 Cities, 11 townships and population of 70,205 residents.

The Carver County Sheriff's Office is seeking dedicated men and women who would like to volunteer their time to the betterment and safety of their community.

As a Reserve Deputy, you will be a member of one of the most professional and progressive law enforcement agencies in Minnesota.

The Reserve Unit, with an authorized strength of 100 volunteer special deputies, helps provide support and assistance at accidents, medical emergencies, search and rescue operations, drowning and water rescue emergencies, emergency traffic control, first aid assistance, role playing for training, light and heavy rescue, water patrol, demonstrations at unit functions, TRIAD events and public events or details in Carver County.

As a Administrative Reserve Deputy you will receive training in law enforcement related skills such as use of force training, communication skills, presentation skills, training on TRIAD, community relations training, and much more.

HISTORY OF THE SAFETY PATROL/RESERVE UNIT

During the year 1955, Sheriff Lester W. Melchert fostered the idea that the existing peace officers in the area form a nucleus for an improved police force operating within the county.

In doing so, Sheriff Melchert set about to encourage local citizens of the county to join the new Carver County Sheriff's Safety Patrol. In time the Safety Patrol was renamed the Reserve Unit.

The major functions which the Operations Division of Reserve Unit are responsible for are; water patrol, snowmobile patrol, security details, policing of the county fair, assisting with county emergencies, patrol shifts as needed, assisting at accidents, residential security checks, traffic control and handling other non violent police calls.

In the latest chapter of the Reserves, they have recently created a new division within their ranks. The Administrative Division is responsible for administrative duties, community relations and the new TRIAD senior citizen program. This division is intended for members who do not have the desire to work the "security" or more physically demanding duties. This is a great opportunity for senior citizens, retired persons and anyone to become involved in their community.

RESERVE REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 for years of age.
- Valid Minnesota Driver's License or ability to arrange transportation (license cannot have been revoked cancelled or suspended).
- Pass a background check, including a criminal history check.
- Attend monthly meetings (last Monday of every month).
- Must pass fit for duty exam.
- Strong desire to help community.
- Be able to volunteer 16 hours per month.
- Strong communication and listening skills.
