Training

- The reserves meet on the last Monday of every month. Typically, meetings provide training in law enforcement related areas. A few examples of training include use of force, Taser, traffic control, verbal judo, crime scene management and field sobriety.









Requirements

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Possess a valid MN Driver's License
- Pass a background check including a criminal history check
- Attend monthly meetings
- Pass a psychological exam



Requirements


- Pass a physical fitness exam
