Class A. Family Day Care:

(A)	10	1	6	A combined total of no more than 3 shall be infants and toddlers. Of this total, no more than 2 shall be infants.

Class C. Group Family Day Care:

(C1)	10	1	8	No more than 3 shall be infants and toddlers. Of this total, no more than 2 shall be infants.
(C2)	12	1	10	No more than 2 shall be infants and toddlers. Of this total, no more than 1 shall be an infant.
(C3)	14	2	10	A combined total of no more than 4 shall be infants and toddlers. Of this total, no more than 3 shall be infants.

(A helper, at least age 13 and less than 18, may be used in place of a second adult caregiver when there is no more than 1 infant or toddler present.)

Class B. Specialized Infant and Toddler Family Day Care:

(B1)	5	1	3	No more than 3 shall be infants.
(B2)	6	1	4	No more than 2 shall be infants.

Class D. Specialized Infant and Toddler Group Family Day Care:

(D)	9	2	7	Of the total children, no more than 4 shall be infants.

Note: *The day care provider's own children under age 11 must be included in the licensed capacity. (Both caregivers shall be adults.)*

DEFINITIONS:

Infant means a child who is at least 6 weeks of age but less than 12 months of age.
Toddler means a child who is at least 12 months old but less than 24 months old for family child care, Class A and Class C1, C2, and C3.
 For family and specialized group family child care, Classes B1, B2, and D: A toddler means a child who is at least 12 months old but less than 30 months old.
Preschooler means a child who is at least 24 months old up to the age of five.
School-Age means a child who is at least five years of age, but is younger than 11 years of age.
