All trainers for these courses must be DHS approved trainers.

❖ Child Development and Behavior Guidance Training *(Repeat Annually)*

- ***New applicants*** - as part of your pre-service training you must complete one of the 'Developmentally Appropriate Behavior Guidance' (KCF - IIC), 2 part trainings, for a total of 4 hours. Both sessions must be completed for credit to be granted. Or you can complete KCF I or IIC – 2 Hours Each, Or 2 KCF IIC – 2 hours each.
- ***Currently Licensed Providers*** - Complete a 2 hour Child Development/Behavior Guidance training (KCF I or IIC).

❖ Supervision Training *(Repeat Annually)*

- ***New applicants*** - as part of your pre-service training complete one of the 'Supervising for Safety' trainings (KCF - VIIb), for a total of 6 hours in person training *(or 8 hours of online training)*.
- ***Currently Licensed Providers*** - Complete a 2 hour Supervision training (KCF – VIIb) or Health & Safety I or Health & Safety II – 2 hour training will count towards supervision annual requirement. (HS I & II repeat every 5 years.)

❖ SUID/AHT Training *(Repeat every 2 years)*

- ***New applicants*** - as part of your pre-service training complete a 1 hour training on SUID (*Sudden Infant Unexplained Death*) and a 1 hour training on AHT (*Abusive Head Trauma*), for a total of 2 hours.
- ***All Caregivers*** – must complete a 1 hour training on SUID and a 1 hour training on AHT.
- ***Currently Licensed Providers & All Caregivers*** - complete a 1 hour training on SUID and a 1 hour training on AHT every 2 years, for a total of 2 hours.

❖ SUID/AHT Videos *(View during the year between the 2 hour SUID/AHT Training)*

Currently Licensed Providers & All Caregivers - During the year between the 2 hour SUID/AHT trainings view the six videos, approved by DHS, online at the DHS website:
