NOTICE TO BIDDERS: In submitting a bid, you must return this complete proposal. You must initial changes made in the Schedule of Prices in the Proposal and acknowledge addenda on the back cover sheet.

To the Board of Commissioners of Carver County:

Sir: In accordance with the advertisement of the County of Carver inviting proposals for furnishing material, and in conformity with the Contract, Plans, Specifications and Special Provisions pertaining thereto, all on file in the office of the County Engineer:

(I) (We) hereby certify that (I am) (we are) the only person(s) interested in this proposal as principal(s); that this proposal is made and submitted without fraud or collusion with any other person, firm or corporation whatsoever; that an examination has been made of the site of the work and the Contract form, together with the Plans, Specifications and Special Provisions for the improvement.

(I) (We) understand that the quantities of material shown herein are approximate only and are subject to increase or decrease; that all quantities of work, whether increased or decreased within the limits specified in MNDOT 1903, are to be performed at the unit prices shown on the attached schedule; and that, at the time of opening bids, totals only will be read, but that comparison of bids will be based on the correct summation of item totals obtained from the unit prices bid, as provided in MNDOT 1301.

(I) (We) propose to furnish and deliver all materials specified, in the manner and at the time prescribed, all in accordance with the terms of the Contract and Plans, Specifications, and the Special Provisions forming a part thereof.

(I) (We) further propose to execute the form of Contract within 10 days after receiving written notice of award, as provided in MNDOT 1306.

(I) (We) agree to all provisions of Minn. Stat. Section 181.59 as amended.

(I) (We) further propose to begin work and to prosecute and complete the same in accordance with the time schedule set forth in the Special Provisions for the improvement.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

FURNISHING BITUMINOUS MATERIAL

PROJECT NO. 2004

1. **GOVERNING SPECIFICATIONS**

The State of Minnesota Department of Transportation "Standard Specifications for Construction", 2018 Edition, shall apply on this contract, except as modified or altered in the following Special Provisions. The AASHTO specification M 140 for Bituminous Emulsion shall also apply.

2. **PROPOSAL GUARANTY**

No proposal will be considered unless it is accompanied by a guaranty complying with the requirements and providing a penal sum of at least equal to 5 percent of the total amount of the bid (under all circumstances and without exception) as provided in Specification 1208.

3. **EXECUTION OF CONTRACT**

The successful bidder shall be required to execute a contract in the total amount of the bid award, conditioned as required by law with sureties (a performance bond and a payment bond) satisfactory to the Carver County Attorney's Office. Upon failure of the successful bidder to execute said contract as directed by the County within (15) days after receiving written notice of the award of the contract, the money deposited as represented by the bid deposit requested in the proposal shall be forfeited to the County of Carver, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages sustained as a result of such failure.

4. **PROPOSAL AND BID ACCEPTANCE**

One copy of the proposal form will be furnished by the County. In submitting a bid, the bidder shall bid on one copy of the proposal. The County reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Bids, or any part of any Bid, and to waive any defects of technicalities or to advertise for new Bids where the acceptance, rejection, waiving or advertising of such would be in the best interest of the County. The County also reserves the right to award in whole or in part, by item, group of items, or by section where such action serves the County's best interest.

5. **AFFIRMATIVE ACTION PROGRAM**

It is the policy of the County of Carver not to use public funds to further any violations of state or federal equal employment opportunity law. Bidders shall express their intent by submitting a signed Affirmative Action Statement with their bid. Failure to submit a signed statement may disqualify a bidder.

6. **COMPENSATION FOR ALTERED QUANTITIES**

For increased or decreased quantities beyond the limits specified by the provisions of Specification 1903, no adjustments shall be allowed in the unit price of the contract item.

7. **BITUMINOUS MATERIAL**

(a) The bituminous material to be furnished shall be asphalt emulsion conforming to the requirements of the AASHTO specification M 140.

(b) The type of asphalt emulsion shall be:

- HFRS-2 High Float Rapid Set asphalt emulsion

(c) The bituminous material will be used for seal coating. Seal coat construction will be done by the County.

8. APPLICATION

All bituminous material shall be applied by the vendor as requested by the County.

9. DELIVERY

The bituminous material shall be delivered in transport loads, as requested, to the county roads indicated on the project location map.

10. METHOD OF MEASUREMENT

The bituminous material will be measured by weight, and the unit of measure will be gallons. A Bill of Lading (weight ticket) stamped by a printing type scale shall be furnished with each transport load of material. The Bill of Lading shall also indicate, for informational purposes, the volume of the bituminous material in the load measured at 60°F (15°C).

11. PAYMENT

(a) Payment for accepted quantities of bituminous material will be made at the contract unit price per gallon.

(b) Payment for freight charges will be made for delivery of accepted quantities of bituminous material. The bidder shall indicate the freight charge rate per Gallon of material on the "Schedule of Prices".

12. SALES TAX

Carver County is tax exempt.

13. DEMURRAGE CHARGES

Demurrage charges for which the County may become liable will be paid by the County separately and shall not be considered part of the contract unit price of the bituminous material.

14. CONTRACT TIME

The contract period shall be between Contract Execution and September 18, 2020, or until project completion.

15. WORK SCHEDULE

Seal coat construction is scheduled to begin in July, and the work is anticipated to take approximately two (2) weeks to complete, weather permitting. Delivery of the bituminous material will be required during this time period.

16. LIABILITY INSURANCE:

The Each party shall be liable for its own acts to the extent provided by law and hereby agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the other, its officers and employees against any and all liability, loss, costs, damages, expenses, claims or actions, including attorney's fees which the other, its officers and employees may hereafter sustain, incur or be required to pay, arising out of or by reason of any act or omission of the party, its agents, servants or employees, in the execution or performance or failure to adequately perform its obligations pursuant to this Agreement.

It is understood and agreed that the County's liability shall be limited by the provisions of Minn.Stat.Chap.466 and/or other applicable law.

Contractor further agrees that in order to protect itself as well as the County under the indemnity provision set forth above, it will at all times during the term of this Agreement keep in force:

- a. Commercial General Liability Insurance Policy with minimum limits of \$1,500,000 combined single limit (CSL), with coverage pertaining to premises operations. In the event Combined Single Limits Coverage is not secured by the contractor, the following minimum limits apply:

\$3,000,000 Aggregate
\$3,000,000 Products and Completed Operations Aggregate
\$1,500,000 Personal Injury and Advertising Injury
\$1,500,000 Each Occurrence
\$ 100,000 Fire Damage Limit
\$ 5,000 Medical Expense

The policy should be written on an "occurrence" basis and not a "claims-made" basis.


- b. Automobile Liability Insurance including owned, non-owned, and hired vehicles in an amount not less than \$1,500,000 combined single limit (CSL) for total bodily injuries and/or damages arising from any one accident. If automobiles are not used, we must receive a letter from you stating this.
- c. Professional Liability Insurance (when required) in the minimum amount of \$1,500,000 combined single limit (CSL). In the event Combined Single Limits Coverage is not secured by the Contractor, the following minimum limits apply:
 - \$3,000,000 Aggregate
 - \$1,500,000 per Wrongful Act or Occurrence
- d. Excess Umbrella Liability Policy in the amount of \$1,500,000 will be additionally required if any of the above policies have lower limits than stated.
- e. Worker's Compensation Insurance.
- f. Prior to the effective date of this Agreement, and as a condition precedent, the Contractor will furnish the County with an original Certificate of Insurance listing the County as an "Additional Insured" in all coverage areas except Worker's Compensation and Professional Liability.

17. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR:

The Contractor is an Independent Contractor.

Nothing contained in this Agreement is intended or should be construed as creating the relationship of co-partners or joint ventures within the County or the Department. No tenure or any rights or benefits, including Worker's Compensation, Unemployment Insurance, medical care, sick leave, vacation leave, severance pay, PERA, or other benefits available to County employees, shall accrue to the Contractor or employees of the Contractor performing services under this Agreement.
