Carver County Sheriff Jason Kamerud reports that on February 19, 2020, Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to investigate an allegation of sexual assault that occurred at Crown College 8700 College View Dr., Laketown Township, on February 14, 2020.

Deputies met with the victim, a 19-year-old male student at Crown College, who reported that two known associates, also Crown College students, came to his home. The two suspects, both adult males (ages 21 and 23), overpowered the victim, removed portions of his clothing, and attempted to sexually assault him. The victim was eventually able to get free.

Deputies also interviewed a witness and one of the suspects. The suspect described the incident as a prank that went wrong.

Deputies arrested Harvey Michael Holcombe (21) and Michael Fletcher Brewster (23) and housed them in the Carver County Jail. Both have subsequently been charged with 2nd Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct by the Carver County Attorney's Office.
