




# Direct Discharge Septic System





## Background

- Bevens Creek (includes Silver Creek) & Carver Creek Listed as impaired for bacteria - Total Maximum Daily Load Study and Implementation Plan completed in 2007
- SSTS (individual septic systems) **that have direct discharges to waters (i.e. little or no treatment)** identified as one source of bacteria
- County Board adopted direct discharge incentive program in 2008.

# Accomplishments

- SSTS Direct Discharge Program began in 2008 and has accomplished the following to date:

- 

- Total participants: **398**

- Loans Taken: **152**

# Background

- Crow River also listed as impaired for bacteria.
- Committee and County Board recommended targeting the Crow River for the direct discharge incentive program in 2020.

# Process


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- \$68,000 WMO funds Budgeted for Crow River
- WMO advisory committee recommend priority sub-watersheds
- Board approves annual program
- County Env. Services implements program



# Eligibility

- **Property located in priority sub-watershed**
- Must have **no previous trigger** (i.e. Current enforcement, compliance inspection as a result of property transfer, complaint, or building permit).
- County will pay cash incentive of **\$2000** per SSTs.
- Loans available - \$15,000 maximum
- Landowner must install system by Sep 30, 2021.

# SSTS Direct Discharge Incentive Program Subwatersheds




# SSTS Direct Discharge Incentive Program Subwatersheds
