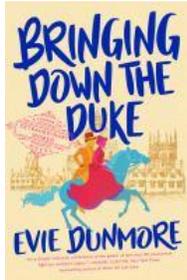
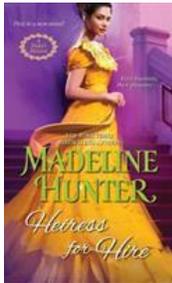


## Carver County Library Suggests *Historical Romance*



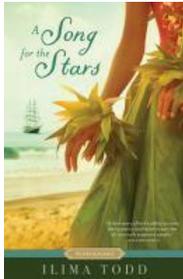
### [Evie Dunmore – \*Bringing Down the Duke\*](#) (DUN 2019)

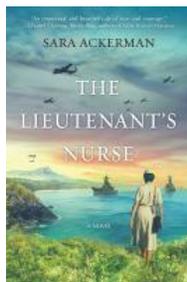
### [Lima Todd – \*A Song for the Stars\*](#) (TOD 2019)

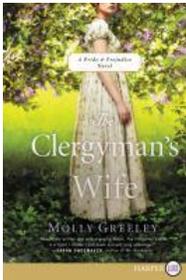
### [Sara Ackerman – \*The Lieutenant's Nurse\*](#) (ACK 2019)

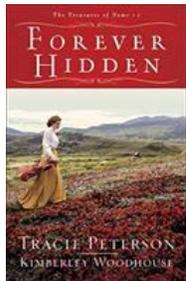
**Mary Pat Kelly – Irish Above All (KEL 2019)**

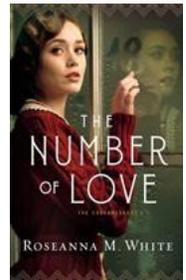
**Molly Greeley – Clergyman's Wife (GRE 2019)**

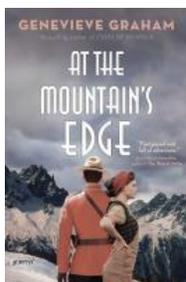
**Tracie Peterson – Forever Hidden (PET 2020)**

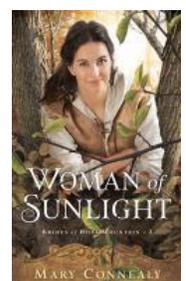
**Roseanna M. White – The Number of Love (WHI 2019)**
