



## Carver County Library Suggests *If You Like Jack Reacher*




### [Mark Greaney – \*The Gray Man\* \(GRE 2014\)](#)


### [Nick Petrie - \*The Drifter\* \(PET 2016\)](#)


### [Jack Carr - \*Savage Son: A Thriller\* \(CAR 2020\)](#)


### [Chris Hauty - \*Deep State\* \(HAU 2020\)](#)


**[Gregg Hurwitz – Orphan X](#)** (HUR 2016)


**[Brad Taylor – One Rough Man](#)** (TAY 2011)
