



Carver County Library Suggests *Second Chance Romance*








[Linda Holmes - Evvie Drake Starts Over \(HOL 2019\)](#)


[Alexa Martin - Intercepted \(MAR 2018\)](#)


Tessa Bailey - Fix Her Up (BAI 2019)
