Carver County Sheriff Jason Kamerud reports that on June 14, 2020 at approximately 2:04 PM his Office received a 9-1-1 call of an unresponsive adult male found in the water near the beach area of Lake Minnewashta off Fir Tree Avenue and Shore Drive in Chanhassen, MN.

Deputies arrived on scene to find David Lee Schroeder, DOB 03/30/1960 unresponsive and not breathing. The adult male was located in the water near a dock and was pulled from the water by bystanders where rescue efforts were started. Deputies continued lifesaving efforts until paramedics arrived on scene and continued medical care. Schroeder was transported to Hennepin Healthcare via ambulance, but advanced efforts were unsuccessful and Schroeder was pronounced deceased.

This matter remains under investigation by the Carver County Sheriff's Office and the Midwest Medical Examiner's Office. The Chanhassen Fire Department, Ridgeview Ambulance and Hennepin Healthcare assisted with this incident.
