




Jonathan Carver Parkway/11 IMPROVEMENTS

Project Overview

The Jonathan Carver Parkway Improvements Project includes the reconstruction of Jonathan Carver Parkway, also called County Road 11, from 4th Street to Highway 61 in the city of Carver. The City of Carver and Carver County are currently designing improvements for the roadway, which are anticipated to be constructed in 2021.

Proposed Solutions and Staging

Expansion from a 2-lane to 4-lane



Roundabout at 6th St and Dahlgren Rd



Signals at Ironwood Dr and Monroe Dr with an additional turn lane at Monroe Dr



Safer pedestrian crossing with a new underpass north of the elementary school.

Full street reconstruction including curb from Dahlgren to Edgebrook



Additional thru and turn lanes for Ironwood Dr, providing better access during rush hours to Carver Elementary.


Stage 1

Intersection closed to traffic

Traffic will be detoured during Stages 2 and 2A via Highway 40 and Highway 61. More information regarding local access routes will be released closer to construction.
