CARVER COUNTY DIRECT DISCHARGE SSTS PROGRAM

Eligibility:

1. Not Eligible - SSTS that are identified as a Direct Discharge or otherwise failing based on a compliance inspection related to a property transfer, complaint or building permit are not eligible for cost share funding. These systems are eligible for low interest loans however.. It is not the intent of the Board to subsidize the replacement of failing SSTS that will be replaced as part of the normal course of life and business.
2. Eligible - A system must meet both of the following criteria to be eligible for cost share and an extended loan period (up to 10 years). A safety net program is also available for persons with extremely limited financial resources.
 - The system must be a Direct Discharge – discharging untreated sewage from a tank or from the dwelling directly into the lake, stream, ditch, tile line or other waters of the state on on to the ground surface
 - Volunteer to upgrade the Direct Discharge system.

Application: applications are to be submitted on forms developed by the County. Completed applications shall be submitted to the Public Health & Environment Division. Applications not meeting both of the eligibility criteria listed above will not be approved

Administration: the program shall be administered by the Environmental Services Department.

Cost Share: the County will pay 25% of the SSTS replacement cost up to a maximum of \$2000 per SSTS in a TMDL priority watershed; however in cases where the SSTS is not located in a TMDL priority watershed, the cost share will be \$2000 as funds are available.

Payment: payment shall be made to the installing Contactor after a Certificate of Compliance has been issues and upon submittal of a final invoice to Environmental Services Department.

Duration: The program will operate so long as funds are available. The Board may, from time to time, appropriate additional funds.
