



Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG) Collection Program

Who qualifies as a VSQG?

Carver County businesses that generate less than 220 lbs. (about 22 gallons) of hazardous waste per month or are participating in a one-time clean out of up to 2,200 lbs.

How do you participate?

- **Identify your wastes and fill out the attached VSQG collection form**
 - Include your EPA Identification number
 - If your organization does not have an ID number, county staff can assist you in applying for one
 - Fill out the waste inventory form including the type or name of waste, total number of containers and total volume of the particular waste
 - If contents of a container are unknown, list as much information as possible

 - County staff will contact you with any questions after receiving and reviewing your application
 - After your application is accepted, you will be contacted to schedule an appointment
 - **Waste will not be accepted without an appointment**
- **Transport your waste to:**
 - Carver County Environmental Center

 - All containers must be labeled and in good condition
 - Containers that are found to be leaking will not be accepted
 - Information on safely and responsibly transporting your waste can be provided to you prior to your appointment
 - Carver County reserves the right to refuse any wastes not transported according to DOT requirements
 - Payment is required at the time of delivery. Cash, check and card (Visa, MasterCard and Discover) are accepted
 - Checks should be made payable to: Carver County

The Carver County Environmental Center also accepts business materials for recycling (such as office paper, corrugated cardboard, etc.).

If your business is only dropping off universal waste (electronics, fluorescent lamps, batteries) we ask that you call ahead so that appropriate preparations can be made. There will be disposal fees for electronics, lamps, batteries and appliances.
